Fresh and frozen whole capelin originating from this fishery, from client group fishing vessels landed at the specified first points of landing in the PCR are eligible to enter MSC Chains of Custody.

Scope of certification is up to the point of landing. MSC Chain of Custody certification will commence from the first point of landing. All further activities from this point will be subject to Chain of Custody certification in accordance with the MSC Certification Requirements.
